

Sites needed for Registry study

This study is designed to investigate whether physician and patient education on calcium and vitamin D supplementation reduces the incidence of hypocalcemia 10 days after treatment with an approved bisphosphonate medication.

The simple study design is ideal for clinicians interested in participating in a clinical study and this Registry study is easy to conduct as part of your regular practice.

The study requires a maximum of three study visits (most patients will require only 2 visits) and a duration of less than 31 days. It involves two blood draws to measure serum calcium, a single intravenous infusion, patient completion of a hypocalcemia questionnaire and a calcium and vitamin D intake diary. As a Registry study, the medication is not provided.

If you have a Paget's disease patient who will be receiving treatment in the near future, please consider participating in this study.
