PAGET'S DISEASE OF BONE

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- I. In 2009, The Paget Foundation is offering one research grant of \$20,000 for basic or clinical research on Paget's disease of bone. There are no additional funds for indirect costs.

- II. This grant will be for one year, but competitive renewal is possible.
(A recipient may not receive a Paget Foundation grant award more than twice.)

- III. The application must be approved by the appropriate committee or group at the applicant's institution. Documentation of this approval must be attached.

- IV. The grant request must include the Foundation's Application Form. This form should be attached to no more than 6 pages of 8 ½ by 11-inch sheets of paper on which the following topics should be covered:
 - A. The hypothesis to be tested.
 - B. Brief review of the subject, including pertinent references.
 - C. Experimental approach and methods.
 - D. Explanation of how the grant will be spent.
 - E. Other sources of funds available to support this project.

- V. A final summary of the results of the study must be submitted to the Paget Foundation within six months of completion of the study.

- VI. Acknowledgement of this grant must be included in all publications based on the study.

- VII. Three copies of the application must be sent to The Paget Foundation, 120 Wall Street, Suite 1602, New York, NY 10005-4001. Applications must be received *no later than July 1, 2009.*
